Matured in oak casks between four to six years and from a selection of the best wines from one single year. Rich purplish red tones, a hint of blackcurrant with a delicious smoky sweetness.
40. **Vintage Croft, Quinta da Roeda, Portugal, 2002** 4.95
Deep dark ruby red, aromas of blackberries and taste of chocolate. A powerful red from Winemaker David Guimarens.
41. **Fonseca Quinta Do Panascal, Vintage Port, Porto, Portugal, 2005** 5.50
Dark colour, aromas of peppery black fruits, taste of violets, blackberry and just a hint of orange blossom.

Sherry

42. **Fino, Sacromonte, Bodegas La Costilla** 3.95
Pale yellow with bright golden tones. Its delicate aroma is reminiscent of almonds, with a broad palate, clean, fresh and dry.

Calvados
